2017 Legislative Action Priorities

Chief Action Priorities

- Mental Health Matters! Keep WV's kids mentally and emotionally healthy in their own communities
- *Medicaid Matters!* Promote adequate funding for WV Medicaid and preserve Medicaid Expansion
- Reduce Truancy! Expand Social Workers in Schools to facilitate school attendance and success
- Increase Addiction Treatment & Workforce! Provide funding for treatment, loan forgiveness, tuition help

Child Welfare, Family & Juvenile Services Priorities

- **Juvenile Justice Reform:** Promote community/school-based prevention & treatment programs
- **Increase funding** for child/ family early intervention/ prevention programs: *In-Home Family Education, Right from the Start, School-based Health Centers, West Virginia Birth-to-Three program, Etc.*
- Support priorities of the Our Children, Our Future Campaign to End Child Poverty in West Virginia

Health Care, Mental Health Care, Medicaid & Related Priorities

- Promote adequate funding for WV Medicaid and preserve Medicaid Expansion
- Increase/apply **Taxes on tobacco, sugary soft drinks, etc.** Dedicate \$ to prevention, cessation, health care
- Keep WV's kids mentally and emotionally healthy in their own communities
- Require **public notice & comment** prior to submitting Medicaid state plan amendments or waiver changes

Professional Social Work Priorities

- Enhance safety measures for Social Workers & other public employees at work & in the field
- Work to meet recommended Caseload Standards in Child/Adult Protective Service, Youth Services
- Offer nationally-certified **School Social Workers** the incentives enjoyed by other school professionals
- Maintain strong Social Work licensing regulations to protect the public from unscrupulous practice
- WV DHHR Social Worker career ladder, hiring incentives & salary enhancement for graduate education

Economic & Social Justice Priorities

- Protect WV's vital social infrastructure supports through revenue enhancements
- **Oppose efforts** to drug test those receiving public assistance, or to establish work requirements for eligibility/participation in Medicaid, SNAP or other public assistance programs
- Create a West Virginia Earned Income Tax Credit program to help struggling low-income families
- Fully implement/fund the West Side of Charleston Revitalization & Transformation Initiative
- Reduce the risk of poverty by providing Voluntary Employment Retirement Accounts
- Support the Consensus Agenda on Disability Policy
- Promote and support passage of laws that promote equality & social justice & celebrate diversity
